Call for papers

Topics

The workshop will cover the full breadth and diversity of applications of AI, statistical or signal processing methods to computer security. Topics of interest include but are not limited to:

- Access control
- Intrusion detection
- Protocol verification
- Protocol repair
- Security policy specification and enforcement
- Information flow control.
- Web 2.0 applications

Publication

Papers will be published in English in the main proceedings of the MICAI workshop.

Authors of accepted papers will be invited to submit an extended version of their papers for a possible publication in a special issue of a journal.

We also welcome papers accepted in the MICAI conference for people interested in obtaining additional feedback and access to a specialised audience.

Submissions

We invite interested members of the scientific community to submit a ten-page paper reporting on novel, original work (**possibly in progress**) where artificial intelligence or a statistical method is applied to solve problems of computer security.
