## INTERNATIONAL MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN CORPORACIÓN UNIVERSITARIA PARA EL DESARROLLO DE INTERNET AND THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA

This International Memorandum of Understanding (IMOU) between CORPORACIÓN UNIVERSITARIA PARA EL DESARROLLO DE INTERNET (CUDI) and THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA (UA), collectively "the parties," serves to outline and confirm the request from CUDI to connect to the UA network. The UA is currently connected to Internet2 via the Corporation for Education Network Initiatives in California's (CENIC) California Research and Education Network (CALREN), CUDI seeks to leverage the UA's position and connect to the UA's network, thereby providing a tertiary/redundant connection to Internet2 for CUDI members. CUDI currently has other existing connections to Internet2.

Given this request, the UA intends to connect to the CUDI-Bestel XC connection link located at 150 W. 1st St., Nogales, AZ 85621. The UA intends to provision a Qwest Metro Ethernet (QMOE) connection from the XC connection to the Qwest Cloud and another QMOE from the Qwest Cloud to the UA campus. CUDI intends to pay UA for the provision of these services, including: the one-time installation charges for the two QMOE circuits; the monthly recurring charges for the two QMOE circuits; and the Internet bandwidth charges for applicable traffic on these circuits.

Final details surrounding this network connection and the associated service charges, invoice terms, payment instructions, and any applicable terms and conditions will be agreed upon by the parties under a separate services agreement. The UA intends to initiate and procure services from Qwest after the services agreement has been signed by the parties. The UA is governed by the Arizona Board of Regents, and the parties intend that the ensuing services agreement be interpreted pursuant to the laws of the State of Arizona. Therefore this IMOU does not contain all the terms to be effective as a services agreement, but instead represents an expression of the intentions of the parties to enter into such agreement.
