Powell also received the Texas Distance Learning Association (TxDLA) 2000 Outstanding Individual Commitment to Service award, the 2002 Don Foshee Outstanding Leadership award, and was the 2011 inductee into the TxDLA Hall of Fame. Most recently, Marci received Polycom's prestigious 2011 CEO Award.
