Christopher Brown is currently an Assistant Professor of Geography at New Mexico State University. He has worked in collaborative research projects with Mexican institutions and researchers for several years, and he was heavily involved with the Tijuana River Watershed project at SDSU in the mid 1990s that produced the first seamless, cross-border GIS database and digital map product. More recently, he is PI of a collaborative database project that seeks to build a web-based distributed database of water resource data in the PDN region. He also has written and published extensively in the areas of binational water resource management, with a special emphasis on watershed-based reearch efforts (Brown 2002, Brown and Mumme 1999 and 2000, and Brown et al. 2002).
