Challenge 6: *collaborative research + policy support actions*

Collaborative research (SSH + ICT): along three 'pillars' inclusive, innovative, reflective societies

INT COOP: Targeted actions –Support Actions- to be implemented taking a strategic approach to international cooperation

Preparing the WP: a long process full of interactions

- **Stock-taking of FP7 and CIP**
- **Commission drafts the WP taking on board stakeholders insights: written inputs, workshops, ad-hoc meetings, AG**
- **Involvement of Commission Services: 12 Units from 5 Directorates and 2 DGs (RTD & CNECT)**
- **Consultation with other DGs (inter-service consultation)**
- **Programme Committee consultations (Member States)**

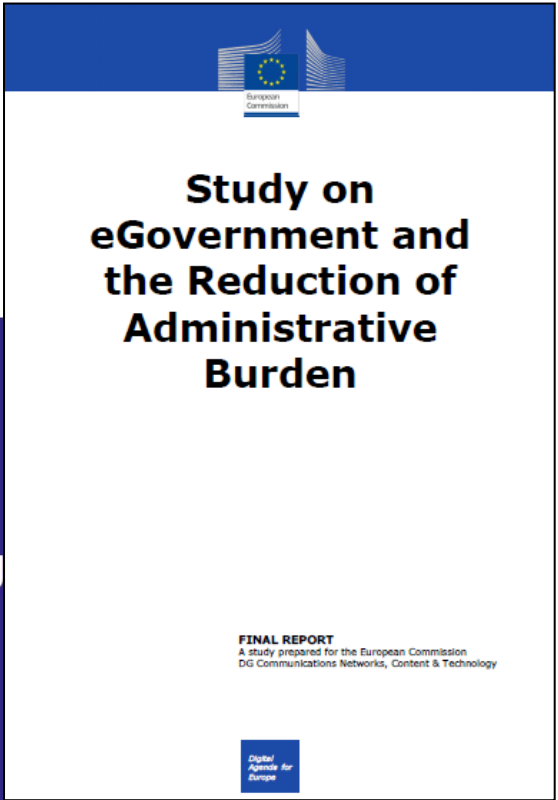
